

Council approves mixed-use zone By David Simon, Times Staff Writer Tuesday, January 13, 2004

The Westminster City Council approved Monday a new Mixed-Use Infill zone along Md. 27 that will allow small businesses, residential units and office space to come into the Md. 27 corridor.

The new zone is intended to create an area similar to the city's downtown Main Street district, said Erik Fisher, technical planner for the City of Westminster.

In other business, the council:

Approved minor renovations to the Carroll County Arts Center. The renovations will add about 1,000 square feet of multipurpose space on the center's second floor, said Sandy Oxx, executive director of the Carroll County Arts Council. Oxx said she hopes the renovations will be finished by this summer.

Approved the name change of "Broadway Alley" to "Paide Way" in honor of the city's partnership with its sister city in Estonia.

Rescinded the city's Water Allocation Policy after a year of heavy rain.
