This means that LPVs will be 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> Grade, DBs will be 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Grade, and BCs will consist of 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grade students starting next Season.
